Conference Dates: 16.30 on Wednesday 14th to 13.00 on Sunday 18th June

Venue: After 12 years our conference returns to its 'spiritual home' at the Goetheanum in Switzerland; where Biography Work 'lives' in the 'department' of *Reincarnation and Karma* in the *General Anthroposophical Section* of the *School of Spiritual Science* at Goetheanum; currently under the mentorship of *Paul Mackay*:

Participation: The Fellowship is dedicated to furthering the development of biography work based on anthroposophy. All colleagues who are working professionally with biographical development are warmly invited to participate in the dynamic, creative process of further developing a fellowship which is dedicated to: **1.** organising and promoting *professional conferences*, **2.** growing and maintaining *international networking facilities* and **3.** supporting the enrichment of individuals and professional communities worldwide through nurturing a resonant relationship between *professional biography work* and the *School of Spiritual Science*.

Language: Simultaneous interpreting in both directions can only be offered for the plenary sessions. Anyone needing translation into their own language is kindly asked to find a 'whisper interpreter' among the invited participants. Working groups will be offered in either German or English, but without translation into the other language. If you need 'whisper translation' in the working groups, please bring an interpreter with you.

Conference Fee: The following price structure for this conference enables you to make a choice according to your financial situation and your professional intentions.
All prices include 3 lunches and 4 buffet suppers in the Speisehaus.

Solidarity price: CHF 430

covers in addition a contribution for discretionary bursaries towards travelling expenses

Standard price: CHF 380

covers meals, refreshment and real costs of the venue, administration and interpreting

Basic price: CHF 330

covers meals, refreshment but only a minimum portion of venue and administration costs

The conference price does not include breakfast or accommodation. If you need separate breakfasts, you can book these during your online registration (see *below*).

Your chosen conference price must be settled by credit card only during your online registration.
